

April 21, 2008, Special Council Meeting
Followed by Work Session

A Special Meeting of the Clarion Borough Council was held on Monday, April 21, 2008, in the Borough Office. President Pro-Temp Joanne Vavrek called the meeting to order at 5:02 p.m. The following Council members were present: Mr. Zerfoss, Mr. Herman, Ms. Leonard, and Ms. Vavrek. Mayor Stroup, Mr. Ragon, and Ms. Freenock were also present.

Vice President Moore arrived immediately following roll-call. She presided over the remainder of the meeting.

Resolution No. 2008-258 was approved following a motion by Ms. Leonard, seconded by Ms. Vavrek. Mr. Zerfoss noted a change to be made to the DCNR project description. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, the meeting was adjourned at 5:06 p.m.

Thereafter, the monthly Work Session commenced.

ADMINISTRATION

The Chamber's request to hang ALF banners will be addressed at the May Council Meeting.

Ms. Freenock noted that Todd Colosimo will attend the May Meeting to seek Council's approval to file the Borough's 2008 CDBG application.

PUBLIC WORKS

Ms. Vavrek noted that they continue to explore options for Main Street.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Mr. Herman had no report but stated that House Bill 2018 has moved from the Local Government Committee to the Appropriations Committee.

RECREATION

Ms. Leonard stated that the Senior League field work is almost complete. A meeting was held with Mike Ebert from the YMCA to interview the candidate proposed to manage the pool this summer.

MANAGER'S REPORT

Ms. Freenock noted that she solicited proposals from local banks to refinance the Borough's General Obligation Note issued in 2003 for the Public Works Building. The rates proposed were higher than the current rate on the note.

On a motion made by Mr. Herman and seconded by Ms. Vavrek, the Work Session adjourned at 5:14 p.m.
