

June 3, 2008, Public Hearing

The Clarion Borough Housing and Zoning Committee held a Public Hearing on June 3, 2008, at 6:30 p.m. in the Assembly Room of the Clarion Free Library, the purpose of the hearing was to receive comments regarding proposed amendments to Ordinance #03-719, Zoning.

A list of those people in attendance is attached to the Official File Copy of these minutes.

Mr. Zerfoss, Chairman of the Housing and Zoning Committee, called the hearing to order at 6:38 p.m.

Mr. Zerfoss reported this Public Hearing is to receive testimony regarding proposed amendments to Clarion Borough's Zoning Ordinance #2003-719. These proposals will provide new standards for dealing with expansion or enlargement of non-conforming structures, provide for Motor Vehicle Repair Facilities as a permitted use in the Industrial District, and provide a definition for Motor Vehicle Repair Facilities which will be added to Section 210-10, Specific Terms, of the Ordinance. The amendments were properly published in the Clarion News on May 20 and 27, 2008. Mr. Zerfoss asked if anyone present wished to speak for or against what is being proposed.

There were no comments.

Mr. Ragon stated the Borough Planning Commission approved the amendments and the County Planning Commission made no comment.

Hearing no comments or questions, Mr. Zerfoss stated these amendments will be brought up for approval at the Council Meeting. The Public Hearing was adjourned at 6:39 p.m.
