RECYCLING IS MANDATORY

RECYCLING PARTICIPATION is mandatory for GRB Residents, as per Ord. 363. New bins were purchased for all properties. Extra bins are available for purchase, \$10 each, at the Borough Office. Recycling collection is single stream and acceptable items include old phone books, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, envelopes, shredded paper, newspapers, cereal food boxes, cans, glass bottles, plastic containers and flattened cardboard. Pick up day is Tuesdays. Refuse is collected Tuesdays and Fridays, four bags/cans allowable with each pickup. **Extra "Orange" bags are now available for purchase, \$3.50 each, in the Borough Office.** Orange bags must be purchased and used when a residence has more than four bags per pickup day.
